Did you know? Up-to-date EU-compliant Play Detectors from Assemblad



With the entering into force of Directive 2014/45, the joint play detector has become a “must have” equipment all over Europe. As a matter of fact, the Directive includes the joint play detector amongst the list of **mandatory equipment for PTI centres**, specifying that *“the device must be equipped with at least two power-operated*

plates that can be moved in opposite sense in both the longitudinal and the transversal directions”, “the movement of the plates must be controllable by the operator from the testing position” and that the equipment must have *“longitudinal and transversal movement of at least 95 mm”* and *“movement speed 5 cm/s to 15 cm/s”*.

Moreover, the use of a play detector for suspension joints play checks is **required at least “for vehicles having a maximum mass exceeding 3,5 tonnes”**.

The name of the **Assemblad** solution is **PG316 Truck Play Detector**, complying with Directive 2014/45 and featuring a hand-held cable flashlight with control keypad and an electrohydraulic unit with 5.5 Kw motor.

Other solutions are also available from **Assemblad** as repair-grade equipment fit for performing pre-PTI checks, namely the **PG314** for trucks and the **G217** for cars.
